

Mother-Daughter Financial Literacy Workshop Participant Agreement

This Agreement ("Agreement") is made between Raising Money-Wise Girls LLC ("Organizer") and the Participant ("Participant").

1. Workshop Details "Workshop"

Date, Time, Location and Fee: as registered.

Description: Mother-daughter financial literacy workshop exploring basic financial literacy concepts.

2. Participant Obligations

2.1 Attendance: The Participant(s) agree to attend the entirety of the workshop, which is anticipated to be 2.5 - 3 hours in duration.

2.2 Participation: The Participant(s) agree to actively participate in all workshop activities and discussions.

2.3 Conduct: The Participant(s) agree to conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner towards all workshop attendees and organizers. Adults are responsible for all minors in their care.

3. Organizer Obligations

3.1 Delivery of Workshop: The Organizer agrees to deliver the workshop as scheduled and provide all necessary materials.

3.2 Support: The Organizer agrees to provide support and guidance to the Participant(s) throughout the workshop. However, ongoing support will not be provided once the workshop has concluded. Participant(s) will have an opportunity to continue working with Organizer once the workshop is complete.

4. Payment

4.1 Fee: The Participant agrees to pay the registration fee upon registration.

4.2 Refunds: The registration fee is non-refundable, except in cases where the Organizer cancels the workshop.

5. No Guarantees

5.1 The Organizer cannot guarantee the outcome of the Workshop and the Organizer's comments about the outcome are expressions of opinion only.

5.2 The Participant acknowledges that the Organizer cannot guarantee results for the Workshop as such outcomes are based on subjective factors that cannot be controlled by the Organizer.

5.3 Organizer makes no guarantee that Participant(s) financial position will improve or that any additional income will result from this Workshop.

6. Confidentiality

6.1 Personal Information: The Organizer agrees to keep all Participant data and information of a confidential nature confidential and not to disclose it to any third party without the Participant's consent. Confidential information shall not include any information which (a) becomes available to the public through no breach of confidentiality by the Organizer (b) was in Organization's possession prior to receipt from the disclosure (c) is received by Organization independently from a third party free to disclose such information (d) is independently developed by Organization without use of the Participant's confidential information.

6.2 Workshop Content: The Participant agrees not to share, distribute, or reproduce any workshop materials or content without the Organizer's written permission. Any information provided during the Workshop is for the personal use of Participant(s) only.

7. Liability

7.1 Personal Responsibility: The Participant acknowledges that they are responsible for their own actions and decisions during the workshop.

7.2 Indemnification: The Participant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend Organizer from and against any losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including with limitation reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) incident thereto which Participant(s) may hereafter incur, become responsible for or pay out as a result of death or bodily injuries to any

person and/or the damage or destruction to any tangible property, or on account of any violation or alleged violation of government laws, regulations or orders caused by or arising out of, Organizer's breach of any term contained in this Agreement, or any negligent or willful act of Participant(S), its employees, or agents in the performance of its duties under the provision of this Agreement.

7.3 Limitation of Liability: In no event shall a party's liability exceed the fees paid under this agreement, whether in contract, tort or under any other theory of liability.

8. Cancellation and Rescheduling

8.1 Organizer Cancellation: If the Organizer cancels the workshop, the Participant will be notified as soon as possible and will receive a full refund of the registration fee.

8.2 The Organizer has the right to refuse registration to a participant at its discretion.

8.3 Participant Cancellation: If the Participant needs to cancel their participation, they must provide written notification via email to the Organizer at least 48 hours before the workshop start time. Registration fees for cancellations prior to outside 48 hours before the Workshop start time may be applied to another similar workshop, online or in-person, depending on availability of space, and at the Organizer's discretion.

9. Miscellaneous

9.1 Governing Law: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of California as applied to contracts that are executed and performed entirely in California. The exclusive venue for any court proceeding based on or arising out of this agreement shall be Los Angeles County, California. The parties agree to attempt to resolve any dispute, claim or controversy arising out of or relating to this Agreement by mediation, which shall be conducted under the then current mediation procedures of The CPR Institute for Prevention & Conflict Resolution or any other procedure the parties may agree. The parties further agree that their respective good faith participation in mediation is a condition precedent to pursuing any other available legal or equitable remedy, including litigation, arbitration or other dispute resolution procedures.

9.2 Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral.

9.3 Severability: If any term, provision, covenant or condition of this Agreement is held by an arbitrator or court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the rest of the of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired or invalidated.

9.4 Notices: All notices, requests, demands, and other communications under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been duly given on the date of service if served personally on the party to whom notice is given or on the day after mailing if mailed to the party to whom notice is to be given, by first class mail, registered or certified, postage prepaid, and properly addressed as follows:
